

# SAMPLE ITINERARY VANCOUVER PERFORMANCE TOUR

*(itinerary subject to change)* 

#### DAY ONE: VANCOUVER ARRIVAL (D) Morning

Arrive into Vancouver, British Columbia!

Ringed by snow-capped, forested mountains dropping down to miles of sandy beaches, Vancouver is a city where you can snowboard and sail on the same day. Against the stunning scenic backdrop, you'll find a medley of sophisticated restaurants, leafy parks, and fantastic shopping.

	Collect your luggage and move through customs and immigration. Meet your local Tour Manager and load the coach.
Afternoon	Transfer into downtown Vancouver for lunch on own.

Late Afternoon	Transfer and check-in to a local hotel.
Evening	Dinner as a group in Vancouver then return to the hotel.



## DAY TWO: VANCOUVER (B.D) – Performance #1

Morning	Breakfast as a group at the hotel. After breakfast, load the coach and transfer to Granville Market.	
	Almost a city within a city, Granville Island is a good place to browse away a morning, an afternoon, or a whole day. Once a declining industrial site, Granville Island started transforming in the late 1970s when the federal government encouraged new, people-friendly developments. The former warehouses and factories now house galleries, artist studios, restaurants, and theaters.

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#### DAY THREE: VANCOUVER (B) – Workshop

Breakfast as a group at the hotel. Following breakfast, load the coach and depart for the University of British Columbia (TBC). Enjoy a *workshop* with a member of the music faculty at the University of British Columbia (TBC). Following the workshop, enjoy lunch on own on campus followed by a tour

Following the workshop, enjoy lunch on own on campus followed by a tour. Afterwards, return to the hotel to drop off instruments and load the coach to transfer to Capilano Canyon Suspension Bridge Park.

A swaying footbridge 230 feet above the Capilano River, the Capilano Suspension Bridge is your pathway through the splendor of a natural rainforest. Walk through Treetops Adventure and Cliffhanger Walk, view the world's largest totem pole collection, and learn about First Nations heritage, culture, and art...all in one spectacular setting!

Evening Return to the hotel. Dinner on your own in Vancouver and this evening is free in chaperoned groups.

## **DAY FOUR: VANCOUVER (B,D)** – Performance #2

Morning

Breakfast as a group at the hotel. After breakfast, load the coach and transfer to Stanley Park where you will have some time to explore.

With 1000 acres of mostly forested land at the western tip of downtown this is one of North America's largest urban parks, and quite literally, is an oasis of wilderness in the middle of the city. The park is surrounded in its entirety by a 9km paved path called the seawall; a great place for rollerblading, cycling, jogging or just taking a pleasant walk.

	Load the coach and transfer to a local venue (possibly St. Andrew's Wesley Church or Richmond
	Gateway Theatre – TBC or similar).
	Arrive, setup and rehearse in this evening's venue.
Evening	Dinner as a group at a nearby restaurant
	Performance in Vancouver possibly at St. Andrew's Wesley Church or Richmond Gateway
	Theatre (TBC or similar). This concert may be shared with a local ensemble.
	Following the concert, pack up and return to the hotel.

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#### DAY FIVE: VANCOUVER DEPARTURE (B)

Morning

Breakfast as a group at the hotel. Check-out of the hotel and transfer to Vancouver International Airport. Arrive at Vancouver International Airport and check-in for your flights. Depart Vancouver.
