## SAMPLE ITINERARY NASHVILLE PERFORMANCE TOUR

*(itinerary subject to change)*

### **DAY ONE: NASHVILLE ARRIVAL (D)**

Afternoon Arrive into Nashville!  
Collect your luggage, meet your Tour Manager and load the coach.

*They don't call Nashville "Music City" for nothing. This city loves a catchy tune, and country music isn't the only game in town -- venues stage rap, rock, jazz and gospel concerts every night -- but country is king. See Elvis' golden Cadillac and Ralph Stanley's mandolin at the Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum, or take in a performance at Opryland.*

Evening Transfer/check-in to a local area hotel.  
Dinner as a group at a local restaurant and then return to the hotel.



### **DAY TWO: NASHVILLE (B,D) – Performance #1**

Morning Breakfast as a group at the hotel.  
Depart on a Guided Sightseeing Tour of Nashville. You will see sites such as the Historic RCA Studio B, the beautiful Schermerhorn Symphony Center, the Parthenon in Centennial Park, and ride by Tennessee's beautiful state capitol.

*There is no better way to discover "Music City" than to travel to the world-famous Music Row. While on this tour, we will visit such points of interest as the Ryman Auditorium, a prior home of the Grand Ole Opry and one of the city's most revered landmarks, and the Musician's Hall of Fame and Museum.*



Afternoon Lunch on your own en route.  
Load the coach and transfer to a local venue (possibly a local high school or community center – TBC). Arrive, setup and rehearse in the venue.  
**Performance** in Nashville possibly at a local high school or community center (TBC).  
This concert could be shared with a local ensemble.

Evening Enjoy dinner as a group; then transfer to the Grand Ole Opry at Opryland.

*Founded in 1925, the Grand Ole Opry is the oldest continuous radio program in the USA. Boasting stars (past and present) such as Dolly Parton, Ricky Skaggs, Garth Brooks, Trisha Yearwood, and Carrie Underwood, the Grand Ole Opry is a classic American institution.*

Following the show, return to the hotel.

**DAY THREE: NASHVILLE (B) – Workshop**

Load the coach and transfer to a local university (TBC – possibly Vanderbilt University or Belmont University).  
Enjoy a **workshop** with a member of the music faculty at a local Nashville area university (TBC).  
After your workshop, load the coach and return to the hotel.

**Afternoon** Lunch on your own in Nashville.  
After lunch, enjoy a visit to the Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum.

*Inside this elegant building, you will find a vast collection of historic video and audio clips, dynamic exhibits, and treasured artifacts that tell the story of the significant contributions made by country music artists.*

**Evening** Transfer to Opry Mills for dinner on own, and the rest of the evening can be spent at this shopping spot.



**DAY FOUR: NASHVILLE (B,L,D) – Performance #2**

**Morning** Breakfast as a group at the hotel.  
After breakfast, depart on a visit to Belle Meade Plantation.

*Once a renowned Thoroughbred horse plantation where the bloodlines of Seabiscuit, Secretariat, and Funny Cide began, the Belle Meade Plantation is now a beautiful 30-acre historic site highlighting the Southern plantation lifestyle.*

Upon arrival, enjoy a guided tour of the grounds and mansion at this beautiful horse ranch.

**Afternoon** Enjoy a Southern-style lunch as a group at Belle Meade Plantation.  
After lunch, load the coach and return to Nashville.  
Load the coach and transfer to a local venue (possibly a local high school or community center – TBC).  
Arrive, setup and rehearse in the venue.

**Evening** Dinner as a group at a nearby restaurant or at the school.  
**Performance** in Nashville possibly at a local high school or community center (TBC).  
This concert could be shared with a local ensemble.  
Following the concert, pack up and return to the hotel.
