SAMPLE ITINERARY SAN FRANCISCO PERFORMANCE TOUR

DAY ONE: SAN FRANCISCO ARRIVAL (D)

Afternoon Arrive into San Francisco!
Collect your luggage, meet your Tour Manager and load the coach.

San Francisco's reputation as a rollicking city where almost anything goes dates back to the boom-or-bust days of the California gold rush. It's always been this way: This city is so beautiful, so exciting and diverse, and so cosmopolitan that you can always find something new to see and do no matter if it's your 1st or 50th visit.

Evening Transfer/check-in to a local area hotel.
Enjoy a Welcome Dinner as a group at a local restaurant.
Following dinner, enjoy the shops along Pier 39, and don't forget to say "hello" to the sea lions!



DAY TWO: SAN FRANCISCO (B) – Performance #1

Morning Breakfast as a group at the hotel.
After breakfast, depart on a Guided Sightseeing Tour including such sights as Twin Peaks, the Golden Gate Bridge, Golden Gate Park, and the funky Haight-Ashbury district.

Afternoon Lunch on your own and time to explore around the Fisherman's Wharf/Pier 39 area.
After lunch, transfer to a public venue in San Francisco (TBC – possibly Pier 39 or a local church).
Performance in San Francisco at a public venue (TBC).

Evening Load coach and depart for Union Square.
This evening is free for some shopping and dinner on own in Union Square.



This one-block plaza and surrounding area is one of the largest collections of department store, upscale boutiques, gift shops, and art galleries.

Load coach and return to hotel.

DAY THREE: SAN FRANCISCO (B,D) – Workshop

- Morning Breakfast as a group at the hotel.
Load coach and depart for a local area university (TBC – such as San Francisco State, UC Berkeley, etc.)
Enjoy a **workshop** with a member of the music faculty at a local San Francisco area university (TBC).
- Afternoon Lunch on own in San Francisco.
After lunch, depart via ferry for Alcatraz Island, where you will enjoy a Self-Guided Audio Tour of this historic part of San Francisco Bay.
- No longer a prison for some of America's most dangerous offenders, Alcatraz is part of the National Park Service and is a must-see for visitors to the city. Once on the island, you will certainly be captivated by its history and its incredible beauty.*
- Evening Dinner as a group at a local restaurant.
Following dinner, attend a Broadway-style performance or a symphony concert (TBC – subject to concert schedule).
Afterwards, return to the hotel.



DAY FOUR: SAN FRANCISCO (B,D) – Performance #2

- Morning Breakfast as a group at the hotel.
After breakfast, depart for a visit to the California Academy of Sciences.
- This is among the largest museums of natural history in the world. The main venues of the museum include a planetarium, rainforest, and aquarium.*
- Afternoon Lunch on your own at the museum.
Load the coach and transfer to a San Francisco Bay area high school (TBC or similar).
Arrive, setup and rehearse in this evening's venue.
- Evening Dinner as a group at a nearby restaurant or at the local high school (TBC).
Performance at a local high school (TBC).
This concert will likely be shared with a local ensemble.
Following the concert, pack up and return to the hotel.
