DAY ONE: Monday, April 3, 2023 – SACRAMENTO → LOS ANGELES (D)

Early Morning	Arrive at Inderkum High School where you will meet your World Projects Tour Managers.
Time TBD	Load the coaches and depart for Los Angeles (<i>approx. 400 miles / 8-hour drive with stops</i>).
Afternoon	Stop en route for lunch on own (<i>possibly in Kettleman City or similar – TBC</i>). After lunch, load the coaches and continue on your way to Los Angeles.
~2:00pm	Arrive into Los Angeles and continue on to the Getty Villa (<i>TBC – subject to schedule and availability</i>). <i>The Getty Villa was originally opened in 1974 by oil tycoon J Paul Getty to display his vast collection of antiquities. With its manicured gardens, beautiful courtyards, and over 1,200 artifacts on display at a time, the Getty Villa is certainly a sight to behold. The relics are organized in themes such as Gods and Goddesses and the Stories of the Trojan War.</i>
~3:00pm	After enjoying the beautiful artifacts and exhibits, load the coaches and continue on to the Embassy Suites Anaheim South.
~4:00pm	Upon arrival, check-in to your rooms where you will have time to freshen up. Later, meet in the lobby and load the coaches.
Evening	Transfer to Downtown Disney for dinner on your own with a \$20 cash handout. After dinner, walk back to the hotel together at your leisure. The rest of the evening is free.

The rest of the day is free to enjoy Disneyland and California Adventure parks!

10:00pm	Later, load the coaches and return to the hotel for the evening.

- ◆ **Accommodations:** Package cost is based on the majority of students in quad occupancy (four (4) to a room) where triples rooms (three (3) to a room) are utilized should student numbers not divide evenly. A maximum of twelve (12) chaperones will be accommodated in double rooms (two (2) to a room) at the same rate as the student multi-share (based on the utilization of two (2) regular sized coaches). Any additional chaperones, or chaperones wishing to be in a single accommodation will be charged a supplement. Sharing beds will be necessary.
- ◆ **Payment / Individual Billing:** All fees are in US Dollars. Payments will be made through WeTravel by ACH transfer or credit card. WeTravel charges a transaction fee for any payments made by credit card. Individual billing applies.
- ◆ **Coaching:** Coaching is based on two (2) regular sized coaches.
- ◆ **Availability / Ground Costs:** This quote is based on 2023 pricing and is subject to availability at the time of booking.
- ◆ **Travel Protection Plan:** World Projects will purchase a Student/Group Protection Plan (post departure) for all travelers of US-based groups (within the 50 states). Details of the plan will be sent to the group leader.
- ◆ **Required Forms:** All travelers will be required to submit signed liability waivers and medical authorizations forms as issued by World Projects to participate in the tour.
